NEW in Saint-Martin-de-Belleville

Prestige: the luxury version of a chalet holiday

These new high-end properties perfectly combine traditional architecture, design and the luxury of space. With more than 300 m², cathedral-style living rooms and panoramic terraces, they offer conviviality in the greatest comfort, along with an endless list of services just a few steps from the ski lifts.

Lenafaju

Built into the hillside over four levels, this chalet respects traditional architecture: stone, larch wood and slate roofs.

Facing a spectacular panorama over the Encombres Valley.

Eden

Chalet Eden blends authenticity and elegance across 280 m² spread over three levels.

Its five bright bedrooms host up to 12 guests in a warm atmosphere, crafted by architect Arnaud Masson, who subtly combines fine wood, natural stone and contemporary lines.

The generous volumes and wide bay windows highlight raw textures and minimalist décor, creating a refined cocoon.

The hammam or the outdoor Nordic bath are perfect after skiing, as is the terrace with its magnificent panoramic view.

Escapade

Located in the heart of the village, this new gem offers direct access to the slopes of Les 3 Vallées.

The cathedral-style living room combines with the central fireplace to create a warm and elegant setting.

The relaxation side is guaranteed by a full spa with sauna, massage room, yoga space, as well as an indoor pool and an outdoor Nordic bath.

The Bell Tower & Alpine Break

This architectural gem, fully renovated last year and located just 50 metres from the ski lifts, houses two magnificent independent apartments. Old wood, noble materials and a wood-burning stove create a cosy, intimate atmosphere.

On the first floor and facing south-west, The Bell Tower offers a privileged view of the iconic bell tower of Saint-Martin-de-Belleville. This 150 m² apartment is accessible to people with reduced mobility and features 3 double bedrooms and 1 family bedroom. Its panoramic terrace is enhanced by a Nordic bath.

On the second floor, and also accessible to people with reduced mobility, Alpine Break showcases all the charm of a traditional Alpine chalet, revisited with elegance. Its 160 m² under the eaves allows it to accommodate 10 people in the greatest comfort. Panoramic bay windows and generous volumes are part of the experience, as is the mountain view from the balcony.
